PETIT VERDOT 2018

Bordeaux growers in France may find its late ripening tendencies to be a challenge, but the Petit Verdot grape has found a home in the New World wine regions like the Okanagan, where it allows for a rich, dark wine that shows off a dense, inky violet appearance, hinting at the ripe, rich aromas of plum and blackberry, solid tannin structure, and a full bodied palate showing off black currants, spices and hints of tobacco on the finish.
