Bordertown's Pinot Noir comes from grapes grown on vineyard location sites on the slopes of Mount Boucherie in West Kelowna, a terroir well suited for producing quality Pinot Noir grapes that create wines that seamlessly blend bright red fruits with interesting notes of earth and spice. Although a delicious sipper, it brings out the best in a variety of food pairings.
